## **Created for Community**



The focus of our Wednesday evenings in Lent was "Created for Community". In potluck dinners and conversations around the table, in singing and praying together in worship, we lived this theme.

Our evenings also included work on a weaving project. Using CDs as a base, we used yarn and ribbon in various colors and styles to weave a circular pattern. This work was intentionally collaborative. Participants were invited to take a CD, weave a little, then return it to the basket, choosing a different CD to work on the following week. These woven CDs were then joined together to make a banner, which will be on display in the sanctuary throughout the long and joyous Easter season.

Weaving is such an apt metaphor for life in community with God and with one another. Individual threads, individual people are joined together, bringing diversity of color and texture, of gifts and experiences and personalities. The thing that unites a woven piece is the strong warp threads. The thing that unites our woven community is the love of God in Christ Jesus.

Diversity can also be seen in the design of each woven circle. There is - intentionally! - a wide color palette, and no prescribed pattern or design. The result is a bit messy, certainly not uniform - and yet, also beautiful! Different styles and colors and patterns come together to make something truly unique. Would our work look "better" if one person, especially one professional, did them all? Perhaps. But perfection is not ever our goal - we are only human, after all! There is indeed something special about the collaborative process and the beauty of different perspectives, ideas, and styles coming together as one.

As the base for this project, we repurposed CDs. In using these discs for something other than their intended purpose, we are reminded of the ways God is "making all things new" (Rev. 21:5). The theme of resurrection and new life is especially appropriate in this Easter season!

Around the edges of each CD you can catch glimpses of the shiny silver finish. My hope is that once the banner is hung in the sanctuary, these shiny edges will catch and reflect the sunlight. As we see this light reflected around the room, let it be a reminder that we are created and called to reflect God's love shown to us and share it with our neighbors.

Thank you to Patti Day for running with this idea - weaving a sample, preparing all the CD bases and weaving needles, and assembling the banner; to all who gave an abundance of yarn and ribbon; to the Binottos for their help teaching; and to everyone who spent time weaving over this season. We'd love to hear your thoughts and reflections on this project!














## **Holy Hikers**

### **Church Library**




